




Our general meetings are listed along with other really great activities around the Katy area.




March Bonus Event

Cheese Ball

From the Kitchen of Diane Leive

8 oz brick cream cheese

8 oz sour cream

8 oz package shredded cheddar cheese 1 envelope of ranch seasoning(you only use 1/2 of the seasoning to make one cheese ball)

1 cup of pecans chopped

Soften the 8 oz brick of cream cheese. Mix the first four ingredients together and form into a ball and chill overnight. Day of serving roll the chopped nuts onto cheese ball and serve with ritz crackers.

Crawfish Dip From the Kitchen of Darlene Wiener

1/2 c butter

1 bunch green onions sliced

1 small bell pepper diced

1 1lb package frozen cooked, peeled crawfish tails thawed and un drained

6 garlic cloves minced

1 4oz jar diced pimiento drained

2 tsp. creole seasoning

1 8oz cream cheese softened

French bread slices

Melt butter in Dutch oven over medium heat, add green onions and bell pepper. Cook stirring occasionally, 8 min. or until bell pepper is tender. Stir in crawfish and next 3 ingredients, cook stirring occasionally, 10 min. Reduce heat to low. Stir in cream cheese until mixture is smooth and bubbly. Serve with toasted french bread slices.
