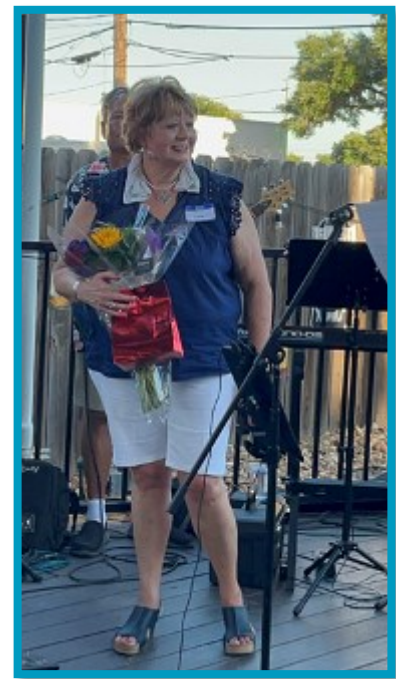

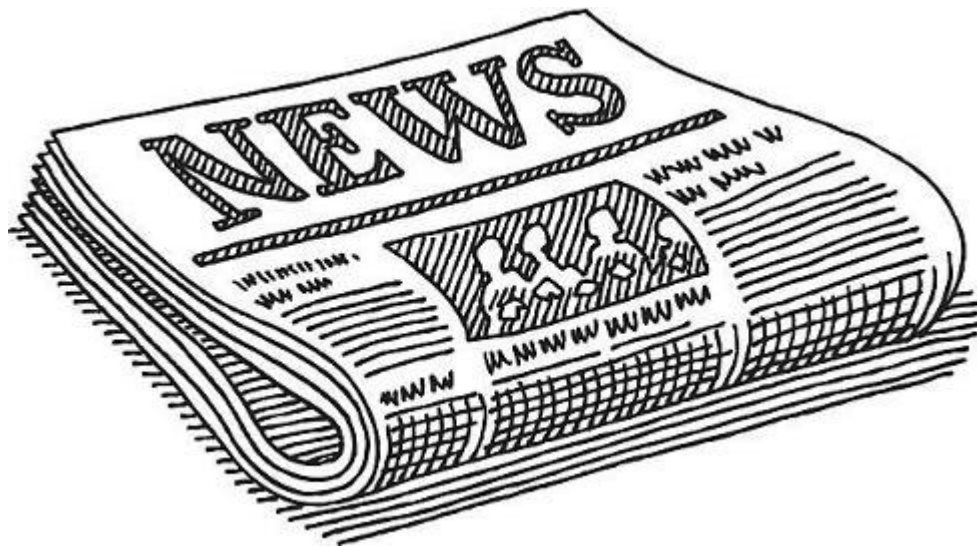

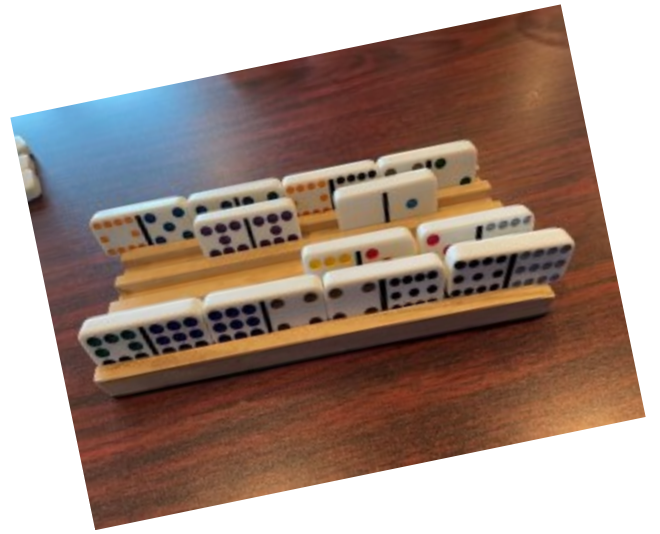

Mexican Train Sub Club Leader, Beth Clark teaching Lisa how to play. Where would we be without Beth...I think she has taught most of us how to play.

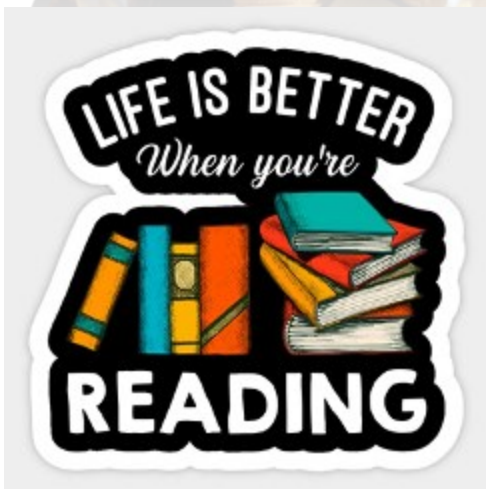
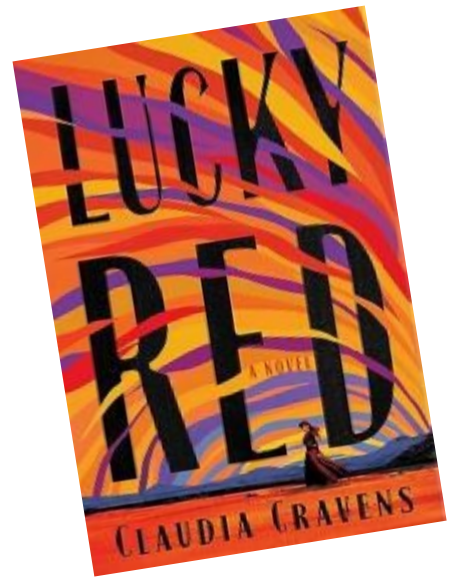




Lisa drew 12 dominoes and was able to line all of them up in a train. Now that may be a first!!
