Christ Clinic is a local 501(c)3 non-profit clinic that can provide the uninsured, underinsured and their families with access to primary care and mental health counseling that they wouldn't otherwise be able to access and/or afford.

Christ Clinic began in 2000 as an outreach ministry in Memorial Lutheran Church in Katy and provided care for around 5,000 patients in 2022.

The majority of Christ Clinics patients face complex barriers to health, including comorbidity, and mental and behavioral health issues. Additionally, patients with more complex diagnoses receive case management services which helped to improve their health literacy and understanding of their care plans.

Christ Clinic promise is to provide compassionate, high-quality healthcare services to all members of the community, regardless of their beliefs or background. They are dedicated to serving neighbors in need and strive to be a source of hope and healing for all who come through their doors.

They also promise to be good stewards of the resources entrusted to them, and to use them wisely and efficiently to benefit the greatest number of people. They are committed to transparency and accountability in all that they do, and to being a reliable partner in the well-being of our community. During the Charity Fundraising Luncheon, attendees will have the option to bid on baskets listed below. All funds raised from the luncheon will be donated to this year's chosen charity, Christ Clinic. So make plans to attend the December 6th Southern Roots and Cowboy Boots luncheon.






