## CRLC November Membership Meeting

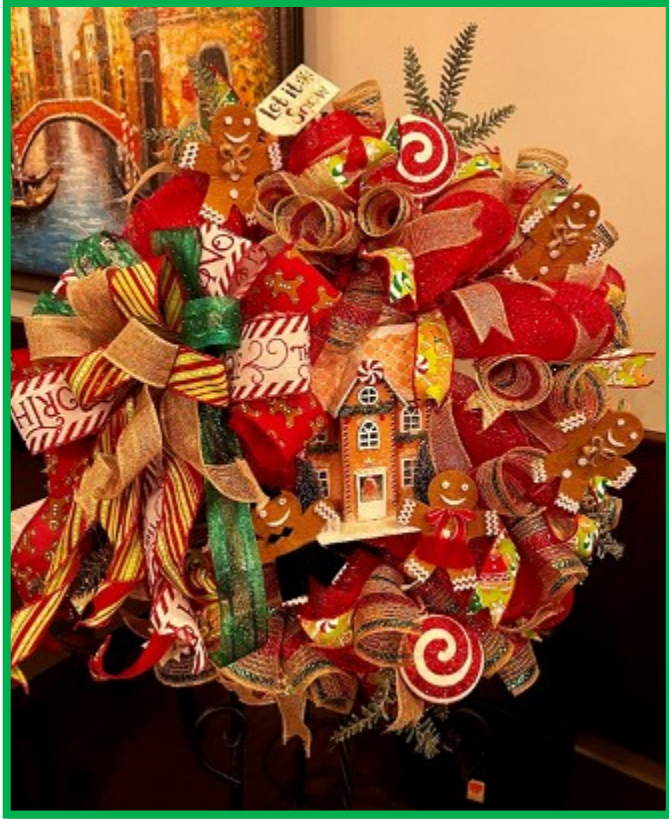
