3. Key Discussions

Welcome and Thanks a Lotto tickets were handed out by Jeana. The icebreaker sheet was passed out by Jeana to be filled out and returned to Jeana. The Board agreed the Executive Board meeting will still meet on the 4th Thursday at 3:30 at Humble Grounds. The CRLC new year launch event will be on Aug. 5, location TBD. We will meet again on June 25 and July 10 in preparation for August Kick Off.

Jill updated the Board of the number of attendees as of May 14, and the headcount was right at 80. Jill asked Beth to ask sub club leaders to send out another End of Year reminder to purchase tickets. Jill updated the board that Local Table restaurant would be the best place to hold the monthly GM. Jill made a motion to use the Local Table as the venue for 2025 – 2026 meeting venue. Tracy 2nd the motion. MOTION PASSED
Jill announced that the holiday luncheon venue will be The Club at Falcon Point on December 5, which is the first Friday of the month. The 1st installment payment has been made to secure the venue. The board discussed only charging \$25.00 for new members joining from March 1.

Those new members would pay the regular membership fee for the following year. No motion was made, just discussed.




