Jeana Dorow thanked attendees for attending this general meeting and last month's meetings. The club now has 218 members and is facing challenges with space and hosting needs. Jeana asked members for patience as alternative solutions are explored. Possibilities could be duplicating clubs on different days. Ways to accommodate more attendees, etc. Jeana also apologized for not seeing any pictures in last month's newsletter. She had a technical issue and lost all the photos.

Patty Lacy said that we have volunteer opportunities, she will send out an evite as upcoming service is needed.

CRLC CHARITY LUNCHEON December 5, 2025

The chosen charity for the CRLC Charity Luncheon will be Lunches of Love (LOL). LOL is a 501 (c3) public, non-profit organization committed to helping end childhood hunger in Fort Bend County by providing a free nutritional sack lunch during extended school holidays and weekends. LOL feeds children in need and those qualifying for the state's free/reduced lunch program. Many children living in families facing food insecurity rely on school lunch as their only meal of the day; without LOL, these children would go hungry when school is not in session.

Lunches of Love was launched during Christmas break 2009 and has quickly expanded during that time growing from initially feeding 150 children each day to serving approximately 2,500 children during this Summer 2025. In addition LOL added the Weekend Edition in Fall of 2011. The weekend care packages include child friendly breakfast, lunch and snack items for chronically hungry children to eat over the weekend.

LOL Facts —

- 1 Sack Lunch costs \$1.25
- 1 Weekend Care Package costs \$3.00
- Over 4 million lunches served since 2009
- Over 27,000 volunteer clock hours donated in 2024

All funds raised from our Silent Auction Baskets and Drawings at the December 5, 2025 CRLC "Tis the Season to Sparkle at Tiffany's" Charity Luncheon will be donated to Lunches of Love. So make sure to mark December 5 on your calendar and make plans to attend the Charity Luncheon. The success of the luncheon and the amount CRLC will be able to award to Lunches of Love depends on YOU!!!!

What was the last TV show you binge-watched?


My TV is on all the time but can say I "binge-watch" any show.

Have questions on how to install Evite App on your phone

1. Download the Evite app:

- Open the App Store on your iPhone.
- Search for "Evite: Party Invitation Maker".
- Tap "Get" to download the app.

1. You can also visit the [Evite website](#) and enter your phone number to receive a download link via text.

• Log in to your Evite account:

- Open the Evite app.
- Enter your Evite email address or username and password to log in.
- If you forgot your password, tap on the "Forgot Password" link and follow the instructions to reset it.

•

• Navigate the app:

- The app interface resembles the desktop version you'd access through a web browser.
- You'll see invitations for events you've been invited to and events you're hosting.
- To view your invitations, tap on "My Events" at the bottom of the screen.
- Select an event to view the invitation.


- **Manage invitations:**
- **Add more guests:** Tap on an existing invitation and then tap "Add Guests" to invite more people.
- **Message guests:** From your invitation, tap the message icon at the top of your guest list, then select the desired recipients and compose your message.
- **Edit event details:** Locate your event under "My Events," tap the three dots next to the event, and select "Edit Details" to change information like the event title, date, time, and location.
- **Edit the invitation design:** Follow the same steps as editing event details, but select "Edit Design" to change the text and appearance of the invitation template itself.
