
The Legend of the Shamrock

Tradition tells that when St. Patrick taught the Irish about Christianity, the Irish had trouble understanding the Trinity. St. Patrick looked down at the ground and saw a shamrock, a three-leaf clover-like plant. He picked it and explained that the three leaves were like the three persons of the Trinity: God, the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit—three, yet the plant as a whole was one. Since then, the Shamrock has been a traditional symbol associated with St. Patrick with Ireland.


