CRLC GENERAL MEETING MINUTES

April 7, 2026

Meeting began at 6:26 pm. Club President Jeana Dorow welcomed everyone and shared details about the End-of-Year Party on June 9th at Katy Vibes. Tickets are \$15 and include dinner and dancing. The "In Time" band will perform. Dinner will be hamburgers and fries, with a meatless option available. Your ticket will be your entry to the door prizes awarded. Please contact a board member to purchase tickets; guests are welcome.

Liz Castle reminded members that our next meeting is May 5th (Cinco de Mayo). Local Table will offer special drinks, and we'll share a year's worth of photos from our sub-clubs. Jill Coble asked members to nominate a charity for the club to sponsor through the Holiday Luncheon and Fundraiser. Nomination forms are available on the CRLC website, and the club will select the charity at the May meeting.

Nancy Creedon reported that the club's bank balance as of 3-19-26 is \$19,058.23

Tracy Bedell, Membership is at 246 members.

Beth Clark asked members to volunteer to lead a sub-club next year. Several groups will need new leaders, including Ladies Night Out, Bonus Events, Dining Out (two co-hosts), and Movie Club. Bonus Events is planning a day trip to Old Town Spring and a visit to Sam Moon (costume jewelry, handbags, shoes, and more). The outing is scheduled for late May.

Jeana introduced our guest speakers, Master Gardeners Shelly Beck and Jackie Sharp brought a variety of plants and pots and encouraged gardeners to repurpose containers if they provide good drainage. They noted that terra-cotta pots remain the best choice for retaining moisture. Soil samples were passed around while they explained the differences in dirt. The speakers also shared practical tips through a slide presentation, which is available at www.fbmj.org. You can also call a Master Gardener with questions. Programs are offered throughout the year on topics such as starting a vegetable garden, transplanting, propagating, composting, and more. T

The program concluded with an excellent Q&A session.
