2026 Charity Luncheon Help Needed

Last year, 62% of the money raised for “Lunches of Love” from our 2025 Charity Luncheon was related to items from businesses. Those donations came from just 49 businesses. That is just a fraction of the businesses that we have in Katy and surrounding area. The goal in 2026 is to reach out to more businesses to increase our donations which will result in more money to be raised for our chosen charity.

So how can you help make this happen? Volunteer to secure donations from local businesses. Now you may be thinking, asking for a donation just isn't my thing but it really isn't hard to do.

Here is how it works:

- A donation letter is provided which details about the luncheon and charity.
- Contact the business either in person or many donation requests can be submitted online.
- If visiting in person, mention you are from CRLC, we are collecting donations for our charity luncheon with all proceeds raised from the luncheon going towards our chosen charity.
- Some will immediately say YES they want to help. Just ask when you can stop by and pick up the donation.
- Some will say they need to think about it. So this requires a little follow-up with the business.
- Perhaps work as a team. It is always easier to maybe ask for a donation if you are with someone else.
- A meeting will be scheduled soon to go over all the details.

2026 Charity Luncheon

The CRLC chosen charity for the December 4, 2026, Charity Luncheon will be “Our Journey”, a 501 (c3) public, non-profit organization. The mission of Our Journey is to be a community for individuals with special needs. Two programs within Our Journey are “Camp Journey and Everyday Opportunities”.

In 2004, Suzette Coates began her career as a devoted and passionate Special Education teacher. While teaching in Katy ISD’s Youth and Child Autism Program, she recognized the lack of summer services available for her students. In 2008, Suzette started Camp Journey, a camp for teens and adults with disabilities to experience traditional summer activities with their peers in a structured and safe environment. The camp last 10 weeks, with a new and exciting theme every week, Camp Journey lives up to its Motto – Everyday is a new Adventure!

Recognizing the need for additional support opportunities after graduation, Suzette made the heartfelt decision to leave teaching in 2014 and founded Everyday Opportunities, a community day program to enrich the lives of individuals with disabilities through connection, purpose and growth. Everyday Opportunities partners with local businesses and other organizations throughout Katy and the surrounding area to provide vocational work opportunities.

We will learn more about “Our Journey” during the October 6 General Membership Meeting.

CRLC is excited that we will be helping this worthwhile organization with all the proceeds raised during our December 4, 2026 Charity Luncheon going to Our Journey.
